26 WHEREAS, She went back to teaching at Hawthorne School in 27 Glen Ellyn in 1975 and returned full-time in 1976 at Christ the 28 King School in Lombard, where all of her children attended; she 29 left Christ the King School in the spring of 1986 to teach 30 sixth, seventh, and eighth grade social studies at Winfield 31 Middle School, where she has been teaching since; and
