1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, On December 26, 2003, Chicago Fire Department Lieutenant Daniel Mullaney was in the fire truck enroute to refuel when he spotted smoke from a fire at a low-rise CHA apartment building; through his quick-thinking and selfless actions, Lt. Mullaney entered the burning building not once, but twice, to rescue two young girls trapped in the building; and

WHEREAS, As a result of his heroism, Lt. Mullaney has been honored previously; he was the 2004 recipient of the Carter Harrison Award given by the City of Chicago; he is being honored this month as a recipient of the Firefighting Medal of Honor; and

WHEREAS, He is a 24-year veteran of the Chicago Fire Department and lives in Mt. Greenwood with his wife, Kerry, and their four children, Luke, Maggie, Mike, and Dan; therefore, be it
