HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The status of fragmented building requirements in 3 Illinois is of serious concern to those involved in building, 4 design, and construction; and

5 WHEREAS, Of the 102 counties in this State, less than half 6 have adopted a building code; and

7 WHEREAS, Over 40 states have adopted some portion of a 8 model building code; and

9 WHEREAS, Illinois already has adopted a statewide plumbing 10 code and a statewide accessibility code; and

11 WHEREAS, Building codes promote public safety; and

12 WHEREAS, Illinois does not have a statewide building code, 13 but does have a collection of building requirements not 14 equitably administered and enforced within the construction 15 industry; and

16 WHEREAS, Illinois citizens are entitled to safe, 17 affordable, and responsible accommodations; therefore, be it

18 ΒY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES RESOLVED, ΟF THE 19 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 20 there is created a Task Force on a Uniform Building Code for 21 the purpose of examining and making recommendations pertaining 22 to the adoption of a uniform building code for the State of Illinois; and be it further 23

RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall be comprised of 2 House members, one appointed by the Speaker of the House and one appointed by the House Minority Leader; 2 Senate members, one appointed by the Senate President and one appointed by the

HR0425 LRB094 12278 LCB 46069 r 1 Senate Minority Leader; one person appointed by the Governor; 2 one person appointed by an organization representing home 3 builders; one person appointed by an organization representing 4 roofing contractors; one person appointed by а union 5 representing licensed plumbers; one person appointed by an 6 organization representing architects; one person appointed by 7 an organization representing structural engineers; one person 8 appointed by an organization representing building trades; one person appointed by an organization representing realtors; one 9 10 person appointed by an organization representing code 11 administrators; one person appointed by an organization 12 representing municipal governments in the State; one person 13 appointed by the Office of the State Fire Marshal; and any other organizations 14 representatives of who express 15 interest in writing of their participation to the Illinois 16 Building Commission or its successor agency; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That the Task Force members shall serve on a 18 voluntary basis and shall be responsible for any costs associated with their participation in the Task Force; and be 19 it further 20

21 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall meet a minimum of 4 times; and be it further 22

23 RESOLVED, That the Illinois Building Commission or its 24 successor agency shall facilitate the Task Force and shall 25 summarize its findings and recommendations in a written report 26 to the Governor and the General Assembly no later than May 1, 2006. 27

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
