- schools in Effingham from 1962 to 1979; she was an Illinois
- 16 State Board of Education State English and Language Arts
- 17 Writer/Consultant of Performance Descriptors/Assessment
- 18 Tasks/Rubrics related to Illinois State Standards and
- 19 Outcomes; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Grunloh was a member of St. Clare Catholic
- 21 Church and belonged to several professional organizations,
- 22 including the National Road Reading Council (president), the
- 23 East-Central EIU Reading Council (president), the Illinois
- 24 Reading Council (Regional 6 Coordinator, Technology
- 25 Coordinator, Board of Directors), the International Reading
- Council, the Illinois and National Whole Language Council, the
- 27 Illinois Council of Affective Reading Education, the
- 28 Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, the
- 29 Illinois Council of Teachers of English, the National Education
- 30 Association, and the Illinois Education Association; and
- 31 WHEREAS, Mrs. Grunloh was honored for her work at the

- 1 International Reading Convention in Las Vegas, Nevada, when she
- 2 was one of four recipients of the Community Service Award in
- 3 1991; she enjoyed spending time with family, working with
- 4 students and teachers, coordinating programs, reading, antique
- 5 shopping, community projects, and traveling; and
