HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Heightened interest in television camera and 3 microphone coverage of court proceedings has come to the 4 attention of the members of the House of Representatives; and

5 WHEREAS, Many states have experimented with and 6 subsequently found no harm in permitting television cameras and 7 microphones in the courtroom; and

8 WHEREAS, The evidence gathered by these states has shown 9 that television and microphone coverage does not disrupt the 10 court proceedings or impair the administration of justice; and

11 WHEREAS, Few people understand the workings of the judicial 12 system; television cameras and microphones in the courtroom 13 would provide the public with a glimpse of what goes on in the 14 judicial branch of government; and

15 WHEREAS, Media organizations in Illinois are pushing for 16 expanded use of television cameras and microphones in judicial 17 proceedings; therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 19 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 20 we urge the Illinois Supreme Court to develop a pilot program 21 to allow television cameras and microphones in courtrooms in 22 the circuit courts; and be it further

RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Illinois.
