Consortium, to oversee the Monkey Pox outbreak in DuPage
County, and to develop the first plan for distribution of the
Strategic Stockpile in DuPage County; and

WHEREAS, He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Missouri at Rolla and his Master of Business Administration degree from Northern Illinois University; he is a registered professional engineer; and

WHEREAS, He served in the U.S. Army, Republic of Korea and Georgia, as a first lieutenant; in the 1980s, he was an officer in the Oak Brook Association of Commerce & Industry; in the 1990s, he served on the Glen Ellyn Zoning Board of Appeals and the Glenbard District 87 High School Enrollment Advisory Committee; and

WHEREAS, From 1970 to 1993, his work in the private sector involved engineering and managing business operations; in May of 1994, he joined the DuPage County Health Department as the Director of Business Operations; therefore, be it
