 12 of the 172nd Stryker Brigade Combat Team and was part of
 13 Company C, 2nd Battalion, 1st Infantry Regiment, stationed at
 14 Fort Wainwright, Alaska; his team is known as the "Arctic
 15 Wolves Brigade"; and
- WHEREAS, He had hoped to return to college after his time in the military to study education and music, possibly to become a music teacher; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Earlier in the year, he had proposed to his 20 fiancee when he was on leave from Iraq; therefore, be it
