5 WHEREAS, The Land of Lincoln High School Region included 6 124 student teams last fall; statewide, a total of more than 7 9,000 students participated in the program; the SMG is 8 administered for students within fourth through twelfth grades 9 throughout the State of Illinois by the Illinois Council on 10 Economic Education, a division of Northern Illinois University 11 Outreach; and

12 WHEREAS, SMG program participants excel in school because 13 experience reinforces education; as students buy and sell 14 investments in their simulated portfolios, they make practical 15 use of cross-curricular skills and knowledge in areas such as 16 math, history, civics, and language; they learn economic 17 concepts in context, which makes a difference in their lives 18 and their test scores; and

WHEREAS, Teachers and their students are recognized with SMG CD cases and Certificates of Award for their successful efforts; first and second place teachers also receive a check which can be used for economic education materials or to apply toward future participation in the simulation; all winning teachers also receive an SMG pocket calculator; and
