1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The American Legion was formed in 1919, shortly 3 after the termination of World War I hostilities; and

- 19 WHEREAS, The American Legion has achieved its position of 20 high esteem through programs of service to community, state, 21 and nation; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Such programs have become an integral part of the 23 State of Illinois; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
 we do hereby proclaim the week of March 12-18, 2006, as
 American Legion Week, and we call upon all citizens, companies,
 and organizations to join with us in commending the good works

- of this organization as an expression of appreciation for the
- 2 wartime and peacetime services of our Legionnaires; they are
- 3 truly "Still Serving America"; and be it further
