1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, In order to gather statistics concerning the 2 3 racial identity of persons stopped for traffic violations, 4 Section 11-212 of the Illinois Vehicle Code was enacted to 5 require every law enforcement agency in the State to compile statistical data relevant to traffic stops, including the race 6 7 of the person stopped, the location, date, and time of the stop, the reason for the stop, and the name and badge number of 8 the officer; and 9

- 10 WHEREAS, Every law enforcement agency is required to
 11 transmit its statistical data to the Department of
 12 Transportation by March 1 of 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007; and
- WHEREAS, Some law enforcement agencies are not in compliance with these requirements; therefore, be it
- 15 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES ΟF NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 16 we urge the Office of the Attorney General to investigate the 17 failure of law enforcement agencies to compile and transmit 18 statistical data relevant to traffic stops as required under 19 Section 11-212 of the Illinois Vehicle Code; and be it further 20
- 21 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be 22 delivered to the Attorney General.
