2 WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 3 State of Illinois are pleased to congratulate Elmer McPherson 4 on the occasion of his retirement; and

earned a Bachelor of Arts 5 WHEREAS, He degree in history/physical education from McKendree College in Lebanon 6 7 followed with his Master of Science degree in education 8 leadership from Southern Illinois University in Carbondale; he 9 has completed his course work for his doctoral degree in 10 education/organization and leadership from the University of Illinois; and 11

12 WHEREAS, Mr. McPherson began his career in education in 13 1972 teaching in the public schools of Cairo, Illinois, where 14 he served as a Middle School Social Studies/Physical Education 15 & Health Teacher, Athletic Coach for Baseball/Basketball and 16 Track, Dean of Students, Athletic Director, Work-Study 17 Coordinator, and finally as Assistant Principal for Cairo High 18 School from 1981 to 1983; and

19 WHEREAS, He became the Extension Course Supervisor/Liaison for three years in the Shawnee Community College in Ullin 20 21 before serving as the Principal at Cairo High School, and later 22 at Edison Middle School in Champaign; in 1992, he became 23 Principal of Stephen Decatur High School in Decatur before 24 moving to the administrative offices in 1993 as Director of 25 School/Curriculum and Assistant Superintendent; he was 26 appointed Superintendent in 2001; and

27 WHEREAS, For the past six years Mr. McPherson was 28 responsible for much of the day-to-day operations of the school 29 district, as well as serving as a key figure in the Decatur 30 schools' shift to a more decentralized decision-making 31 structure; he was involved with the successful local tax HR1081 -2- LRB094 19980 HSS 57397 r 1 referendum passed in February 2001, the first such success 2 since 1956; and

3 of the highlights of his time WHEREAS, Some as 4 superintendent in Decatur include the development of Hope School, a K-8 building that is the first school in the district 5 to go to a balanced or year-round calendar; the Professional 6 7 Development Institute; the Phoenix Enrichment Center, an alternative school, and Phoenix II, a center for teen moms; the 8 development of a strategic plan; and the organization of a 9 10 Superintendent Youth Council; and

11 WHEREAS, He is a member of the United Way Board, the Metro 12 Decatur Chamber of Commerce, the Joint Drop Out Task Force, the 13 Decatur Public Schools Foundation, Webster-Cantrell Hall, Boys 14 and Girls Club of Decatur, and numerous other civic and 15 professional organizations; and

16 WHEREAS, He and his wife, Naomi, live in Decatur where 17 Naomi serves as Coordinator for Accelerated Schools with a home 18 base in Decatur; therefore, be it
