cost-effective means of reducing stray and feral cat

WHEREAS, TNR stops the cycle of breeding, ends the killing

WHEREAS, TNR stops the cycle of breeding, ends the killing of healthy animals, and reduces complaints about and costs associated with feral cats; and

WHEREAS, Scientific evidence and experience in the United States and other countries demonstrates that non-lethal TNR, accompanied by ongoing feral cat colony management, is the only way to reduce feral cat populations in the long-term; and

WHEREAS, Caring individuals and groups are effectively applying TNR to feral cat colonies all across Illinois; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
we endorse non-lethal Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR), when
accompanied by ongoing feral cat management, as the most
effective, humane method of reducing feral cat populations in
Illinois; and be it further
