WHEREAS, The Schorsch Village Improvement Association will celebrate its Diamond Anniversary on Saturday, September 16, 2006, at Schorsch Village Hall, 6940 W. Belmont in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, On July 13, 1931, the Schorsch Village Improvement Association held the first meeting of an association of neighbors of 70 home owners for the purposes of organizing an improvement and social group for the mutual benefit of their neighborhood, including holiday celebrations, picnics, dances, enforcement of the local laws, and protecting themselves with strict enforcement of building and fire ordinances, and always looking for new ways to beautify and improve their village; and

WHEREAS, The Schorsch Village Improvement Association received a Charter of Incorporation on May 29, 1939, to incorporate the above purposes for residences of outstanding architectural design, grammar schools, and high schools in their district for their children and churches for their parishioners, and the publishing of a newsletter called "The Schorsch Village Informer"; therefore, be it
