## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the 3 State of Illinois are pleased to congratulate Ruby Dee on being 4 the 2006 recipient of the Lifetime Achievement Award from the 5 Chicago International Film Festival Black Perspectives; and WHEREAS, Ruby Dee was born on October 27, 1924, 6 7 Cleveland, Ohio, and grew up in Harlem, New York; she graduated 8 from Hunter College in 1945 with degrees in French and Spanish; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, Ms. Dee made several appearances on Broadway before receiving national recognition for her role in the film 11 "The Jackie Robinson Story"; her acting career has crossed all 12 13 major forms of media over a span of eight decades; and WHEREAS, She has been nominated for eight Emmy Awards and 14 15 won two, one for her role in "Decoration Day" and once for a 16 quest appearance on the program "China Beach"; and WHEREAS, Ms. Dee and her late husband, actor Ossie Davis, 17 18 were well-known civil rights activists; she has been a member of CORE, the NAACP, the Student Nonviolent Coordinating 19 Committee, and the Southern Christian Leadership Conference; 20 21 and 22 WHEREAS, She has appeared in more than 20 films, and her

23 notable stage appearances include roles in "A Raisin in the 24 Sun" and Genet's "The Balcony"; in addition to her two Emmy 25 awards, her acting has been honored with an Obie Award in 1971 26 for her performance in Athol Fugard's "Boesman and Lena", a Drama Desk Award in 1972 for her role in "Wedding Band", and an 2.7 28 Ace Award for her ground-braking performance as Mary Tyrone in Eugene O'Neill's "Long Day's Journey into Night"; as Kate in 29 "The Taming of the Shrew" and Cordelia in "King Lear", in 1965, 30

- 1 she became the first African-American woman to play major parts
- in the American Shakespeare Festival; she has written plays,
- 3 musicals, and several books of poetry, and she turned her own
- 4 stories and folk tales into the 1998 one-woman show "One Good
- 5 Nerve"; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In 1988, she was inducted into the American
- 7 Theatre Hall of Fame; along with her husband, she has been
- 8 inducted into the NAACP Image Awards Hall of Fame, awarded the
- 9 Silver Circle Award by the Academy of Television Arts and
- 10 Sciences, the National Medal of Arts Award, and the Screen
- 11 Actors Guild's Lifetime Achievement Award; in December 2004,
- they were recipients of the John F. Kennedy Center Honors for
- their contributions to the performing arts; she is a member of
- 14 Actors' Equity Association, the Screen Actors Guild, the
- 15 American Federation of Television and Radio Artists, and the
- 16 Writers Guild; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In honor of her many achievements, Ms. Dee will
- 18 receive the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Chicago
- 19 International Film Festival Black Perspectives on Friday,
- 20 October 13, 2006; therefore, be it
- 21 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 22 NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 23 we congratulate Ruby Dee on receiving the Lifetime Achievement
- 24 Award from the Chicago International Film Festival Black
- 25 Perspectives; and be it further
- 26 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 27 presented to Ms. Dee as an expression of our deep respect and
- 28 esteem.
