AN ACT concerning firearm ammunition.

## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
  amended by changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 65/3) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-3)

7 Sec. 3. (a) Except as provided in Section 3a, no person may 8 knowingly transfer, or cause to be transferred, any firearm or any firearm ammunition to any person within this State unless 9 the transferee with whom he deals displays a currently valid 10 Firearm Owner's Identification Card which has previously been 11 issued in his name by the Department of State Police under the 12 provisions of this Act. In addition, all firearm transfers by 13 14 federally licensed firearm dealers are subject to Section 3.1.

15 (b) Any person within this State who transfers or causes to be transferred any firearm shall keep a record of such transfer 16 17 for a period of 10 years from the date of transfer. Such record 18 shall contain the date of the transfer; the description, serial 19 number or other information identifying the firearm if no serial number is available; and, if the transfer was completed 20 21 within this State, the transferee's Firearm Owner's 22 Identification Card number. On demand of a peace officer such 23 transferor shall produce for inspection such record of transfer. 24

25 (b-5) Any resident may purchase ammunition from a person 26 outside of Illinois. Any resident purchasing ammunition outside the State of Illinois must provide the seller with a 27 copy of his or her Firearm Owner's Identification Card and 28 either his or her Illinois driver's license or Illinois State 29 30 Identification Card prior to the shipment of the ammunition. The ammunition may be shipped only to an address on either of 31 those 2 documents. 32
