Amends the Illinois Early Learning Council Act. Provides that the Council shall act in coordination with the Interagency Nutrition Council when dealing with activities related to nutrition, nutrition education, and physical activity.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Early Learning Council Act is amended by changing Section 5 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 3933/5)
- 7 Sec. 5. Illinois Early Learning Council. The Illinois Early Learning Council is hereby created to coordinate existing 8 programs and services for children from birth to 5 years of age 9 in order to better meet the early learning needs of children 10 and their families. The goal of the Council is to fulfill the 11 12 vision of a statewide, high-quality, accessible, comprehensive early learning system to benefit all young 13 14 children whose parents choose it. The Council shall guide collaborative efforts to improve and expand upon existing early 15 childhood programs and services, including those related to 16 17 nutrition, nutrition education, and physical activity, in coordination with the Interagency Nutrition Council. This work 18 19 shall include making use of existing reports, research, and planning efforts. 20
