1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Energy Assistance Act is amended by changing

 Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 20/4) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 1404)
- 7 Sec. 4. Energy Assistance Program.
- (a) The Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity 8 Community Affairs is hereby authorized to institute a program 9 to ensure the availability and affordability of heating and 10 electric service to low income citizens. The Department shall 11 implement the program by rule promulgated pursuant to The 12 Illinois Administrative Procedure Act. The program shall be 13 14 consistent with the purposes and objectives of this Act and 15 with all other specific requirements provided herein. The Department may enter into such contracts and other agreements 16 17 with local agencies as may be necessary for the purpose of 18 administering the energy assistance program.
 - A township may administer the energy assistance program in the territory within its jurisdiction. The Department of Public Aid shall adopt rules as necessary to implement the changes made by this amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly. The rules shall include, but need not be limited to, (i) provisions setting forth the conditions under which a township may administer the energy assistance program in the territory within its jurisdiction and (ii) provisions for such a township to participate in State and federal funding of the energy assistance program.
 - (b) Nothing in this Act shall be construed as altering or limiting the authority conferred on the Illinois Commerce Commission by the Public Utilities Act to regulate all aspects of the provision of public utility service, including but not

- 1 limited to the authority to make rules and adjudicate disputes
- 2 between utilities and customers related to eligibility for
- 3 utility service, deposits, payment practices, discontinuance
- 4 of service, and the treatment of arrearages owing for
- 5 previously rendered utility service.
