## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

730 ILCS 5/3-12-5 from Ch. 38, par. 1003-12-5

Amends the Unified Code of Corrections. Provides that a prisoner performing a work assignment in a correctional employment program shall receive a daily wage of $\$ 25$ or a higher amount determined by administrative rule of the Department of Corrections.

#### Abstract

Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by


 changing Section 3-12-5 as follows:```
    (730 ILCS 5/3-12-5) (from Ch. 38, par. 1003-12-5)
    Sec. 3-12-5. Compensation. A person persons performing a
work assignment under subsection (a) of Section 3-12-2 shall
may receive a wage of $25 per day or a higher amount
established under rules of the
Department. In determining rates of compensation if more than
$25 per day, the Department shall consider the effort, skill
and economic value of the work performed. Compensation may be
given to persons who participate in other programs of the
Department. Of the compensation earned pursuant to this
Section, a portion, as determined by the Department, shall be
used to offset the cost of the committed person's
incarceration. If the committed person files a lawsuit
determined frivolous under Article XXII of the Code of Civil
Procedure, 50% of the compensation shall be used to offset the
filing fees and costs of the lawsuit as provided in that
Article until all fees and costs are paid in full. All other
wages shall be deposited in the individual's account under
rules and regulations of the Department. The Department shall
notify the Attorney General of any compensation applied towards
a satisfaction, in whole or in part, of the person's
incarceration costs.
