SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/12-610.1 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a person who holds an instruction permit or a graduated license may not use a wireless phone while driving a vehicle. Provides that the prohibition does not apply to use of a wireless phone to contact a law enforcement agency, health care provider, or emergency services agency for emergency purposes. Effective immediately.

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 12-610.1 as follows:

7 Sec. 12-610.1. Wireless telephones.

(a) As used in this Section, "wireless telephone" means a 8 device that is capable of transmitting or receiving telephonic 9 communications without a wire connecting the device to the 10 telephone network. 11 12 (b) A person who holds an instruction permit issued under Section 6-105 or 6-107.1, or a person who holds a graduated 13 license issued under Section 6-107, may not drive a vehicle 14 15 while using a wireless phone. (c) This Section does not apply to a person using a 16
