1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 7-316.1 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/7-316.1 new)
- Sec. 7-316.1. Nonresidents and former residents; when
- 8 proof not required.
- 9 <u>(a) Any nonresident or former Illinois resident who (i) has</u>
- 10 met all requirements for reinstatement of his or her driving or
- 11 registration privileges under this Chapter except for filing
- 12 proof of financial responsibility, (ii) resides outside of
- 13 <u>Illinois, and (iii) has applied for a driver's license in</u>
- 14 <u>another state</u>, shall be released from the requirement of
- 15 <u>showing proof of financial responsibility in this State if he</u>
- or she presents to the Secretary of State, in a manner
- 17 <u>satisfactory to the Secretary, notice of his or her</u>
- 18 <u>out-of-state residency.</u>
- 19 (b) Any nonresident or former Illinois resident whose
- 20 driver's license was revoked and who (i) has met all
- 21 requirements for applying for driving privileges except for
- filing proof of financial responsibility under this Chapter,
- 23 (ii) resides outside of Illinois, and (iii) has applied for a
- 24 <u>driver's license in another state, shall be released from the</u>
- 25 <u>requirement of showing proof of financial responsibility in</u>
- 26 <u>this State if he or she presents to the Secretary of State, in</u>
- 27 <u>a manner satisfactory to the Secretary, notice of his or her</u>
- 28 out-of-state residency.
- 29 (c) If a nonresident or former Illinois resident released
- 30 from the requirement of showing proof of financial
- 31 responsibility in this State under subsection (a) or subsection
- 32 (b) of this Section moves or returns to this State within 3

years of the date of release, that person must present to the 1 2 Secretary of State, in a manner satisfactory to the Secretary, 3 proof of insurance coverage during the period in which the person lived outside of Illinois. A person who fails to present 4 5 the required proof may not be issued a driver's license until he or she presents proof of financial responsibility that is 6 satisfactory under this Chapter. The proof of financial 7 responsibility required under this subsection (c) must be shown 8 9 or maintained for the period of time required under this Chapter. 10 11 (d) The Secretary shall adopt rules for implementing this 12 Section.
