AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Plumbing License Law is amended by
changing Section 13.1 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 320/13.1)

7 Sec. 13.1. Plumbing contractors; registration;
8 applications.

9 (1) On and after May 1, 2002, all persons or corporations 10 desiring to engage in the business of plumbing contractor, 11 other than any entity that maintains an audited net worth of 12 shareholders' equity equal to or exceeding \$100,000,000, shall 13 register in accordance with the provisions of this Act.

14 (2) Application for registration shall be filed with the
15 Department each year, on or before the last day of <u>September</u>
16 April, in writing and on forms prepared and furnished by the
17 Department. All plumbing contractor registrations expire on
18 the last day of <u>September</u> April of each year.

19 (3) Applications shall contain the name, address, and 20 telephone number of the person and the plumbing license of (i) the individual, if a sole proprietorship; (ii) the partner, if 21 22 a partnership; or (iii) an officer, if a corporation. The application shall contain the business name, address, 23 and telephone number, a current copy of the plumbing license, and 24 25 any other information the Department may require by rule.

(4) Applicants shall submit an original certificate of
insurance documenting that the contractor carries general
liability insurance with a minimum of \$100,000 per occurrence,
bodily injury insurance with a minimum of \$300,000 per
occurrence, property damage insurance with a minimum of
\$50,000, and workers compensation insurance with a minimum
\$500,000. No registration may be issued in the absence of this

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certificate. Certificates must be in force at all times for
 registration to remain valid.

3 (5) Applicants shall submit, on a form provided by the 4 Department, an indemnification bond in the amount of \$20,000 or 5 a letter of credit in the same amount for work performed in 6 accordance with this Act and the rules promulgated under this 7 Act.

8 (6) All employees of a registered plumbing contractor who 9 engage in plumbing work shall be licensed plumbers or 10 apprentice plumbers in accordance with this Act.

11 (7) Plumbing contractors shall submit an annual12 registration fee in an amount to be established by rule.

(8) The Department shall be notified in advance of any changes in the business structure, name, or location or of the addition or deletion of the owner or officer who is the licensed plumber listed on the application. Failure to notify the Department of this information is grounds for suspension or revocation of the plumbing contractor's registration.

19 In the event that the plumber's license on the (9) application for registration of a plumbing contractor is a 20 issued by the City of Chicago, it shall be 21 license the 22 responsibility of the applicant to forward a copy of the 23 plumber's license to the Department, noting the name of the 24 registered plumbing contractor, when it is renewed.
