

94TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 SB0330

Introduced 2/15/2005, by Sen. Larry K. Bomke

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 685/3 from Ch. 23, par. 2358-3 720 ILCS 685/4 from Ch. 23, par. 2358-4

Amends the Tobacco Accessories and Smoking Herbs Control Act. Prohibits the sale, barter, exchange, delivery, and giving away of flavored cigarettes (in addition to bidi cigarettes). Effective immediately.

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1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Tobacco Accessories and Smoking Herbs 5 Control Act is amended by changing Sections 3 and 4 as follows:
- (720 ILCS 685/3) (from Ch. 23, par. 2358-3) 6
- 7 Sec. 3. Definitions. The following definitions shall apply 8 to this Act:
- (a) "Tobacco accessories" shall mean cigarette papers, 9 pipes, holders of smoking materials of all types, cigarette 10 rolling machines, and other items, designed primarily for the 11 smoking or ingestion of tobacco products or of substances made 12 illegal under any statute or of substances whose sale, gift, 13
- 14 barter, or exchange is made unlawful under this Act.
- (b) "Smoking herbs" shall mean all substances of plant 15 origin and their derivatives, including but not limited to 16 17 broom, calea, California poppy, damiana, hops, ginseng, 18 lobelia, jimson weed and other members of the Datura genus, 19 passion flower and wild lettuce, which are processed or sold 20 primarily for use as smoking materials.
 - (c) "Bidi cigarette" means a product that contains tobacco that is wrapped in temburni or tendu leaf or that is wrapped in any other material identified by rules of the Department of Public Health that is similar in appearance or characteristics to the temburni or tendu leaf.
- (d) "Flavored cigarette" means a cigarette or any of its 26 component parts (including the tobacco, filter, or paper) that 27 28 contains, as a constituent (including a smoke constituent) or additive, an artificial or natural flavor (other than tobacco 29 30 or menthol) or an herb or spice, including strawberry, grape, orange, clove, cinnamon, pineapple, vanilla, coconut, 31 licorice, cocoa, chocolate, cherry, or coffee, that is a 32

- 4 Sec. 4. Offenses.
- 5 (a) Sale to minors. No person shall knowingly sell, barter,
 6 exchange, deliver or give away or cause or permit or procure to
 7 be sold, bartered, exchanged, delivered, or given away tobacco
 8 accessories or smoking herbs to any person under 18 years of
 9 age.
- (a-5) Sale of bidi <u>and flavored</u> cigarettes. No person shall knowingly sell, barter, exchange, deliver, or give away a bidi or <u>flavored</u> cigarette to another person, nor shall a person cause or permit or procure a bidi <u>or flavored</u> cigarette to be sold, bartered, exchanged, delivered, or given away to another person.
 - (b) Sale of cigarette paper. No person shall knowingly offer, sell, barter, exchange, deliver or give away cigarette paper or cause, permit, or procure cigarette paper to be sold, offered, bartered, exchanged, delivered, or given away except from premises or an establishment where other tobacco products are sold. For purposes of this Section, "tobacco products" means cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco, or tobacco in any of its forms.
 - (c) Sale of cigarette paper from vending machines. No person shall knowingly offer, sell, barter, exchange, deliver or give away cigarette paper or cause, permit, or procure cigarette paper to be sold, offered, bartered, exchanged, delivered, or given away by use of a vending or coin-operated machine or device. For purposes of this Section, "cigarette paper" shall not include any paper that is incorporated into a product to which a tax stamp must be affixed under the Cigarette Tax Act or the Cigarette Use Tax Act.
- 33 (d) Use of identification cards. No person in the 34 furtherance or facilitation of obtaining smoking accessories 35 and smoking herbs shall display or use a false or forged

- 1 identification card or transfer, alter, or deface an
 2 identification card.
- 3 (e) Warning to minors. Any person, firm, partnership, 4 company or corporation operating a place of business where 5 tobacco accessories and smoking herbs are sold or offered for sale shall post in a conspicuous place upon the premises a sign 6 7 upon which there shall be imprinted the following statement, "SALE OF TOBACCO ACCESSORIES AND SMOKING HERBS TO PERSONS UNDER 8 EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE OR THE MISREPRESENTATION OF AGE TO 9 PROCURE SUCH A SALE IS PROHIBITED BY LAW". The sign shall be 10 printed on a white card in red letters at least one-half inch 11 12 in height.

- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
