Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Force
 Fed Birds Act.

- 8 (1) A "bird" includes, but is not limited to, a duck 9 or goose.
- 10 (2) "Force feeding a bird" means a process that causes
 11 the bird to consume more food than a typical bird of the
 12 same species would consume voluntarily. Force feeding
 13 methods include, but are not limited to, delivering feed
 14 through a tube or other device inserted into the bird's
 15 esophagus.
 - (b) A person may not force feed a bird for the purpose of enlarging the bird's liver beyond normal size or hire another person to do so.
- 19 (c) A person who knowingly violates this Section is guilty 20 of a petty offense and shall be fined \$1,000. Each day that a 21 violation occurs is a separate offense.
