Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 8 Sec. 3-606. A peace officer may take a person into custody
- 9 and transport him to a mental health facility when, as a result
- of his personal observation, the peace officer has reasonable
- 11 grounds to believe that the person is subject to involuntary
- 12 admission and in need of immediate hospitalization to protect
- 13 such person or others from physical harm. Upon arrival at the
- 14 facility, the peace officer $\underline{\text{may}}$ $\underline{\text{shall}}$ complete the petition
- under Section 3-601. <u>If the petition is not completed by the</u>
- 16 peace officer transporting the person, the transporting
- officer's name, badge number, and employer shall be included in
- 18 the petition as a potential witness as provided in Section
- 19 3-601 of this Chapter.
