10	appointments". <u>Intern or trainee</u> <del>Trainee</del> appointments may be
11	made with or without examination, with consideration of the
12	needs of Illinois residents, but may not be made to positions
13	in any class that is not in <u>an intern program or</u> a trainee
14	program approved by the Director of Central Management
15	Services. <u>Intern programs and trainee</u> <del>Trainee</del> programs will be
16	developed with consideration of the need for employees with
17	linguistic abilities or cultural knowledge. The Director shall
18	work with the Department of Human Services and the Department
19	of Employment Security in <u>intern or</u> trainee position placements
20	for those persons who receive benefits from those Departments.
21	Persons who receive <u>intern or</u> trainee appointments do not
22	acquire any rights under jurisdiction B of the Personnel Code

not been granted a veteran preference may not be appointed in 1 2 other than an intern or trainee capacity to a position subject 3 to this Act when the name of an otherwise qualified recipient of a veteran preference appears on the list of persons eligible 4 5 for appointment to that position. An intern or trainee, or former intern or trainee, who has 6 7 not been granted a veteran preference may not be appointed to a position subject to this Act with the intent to avoid or evade 8 the public policy of preferring an otherwise qualified veteran 9 10 for such a position.
