35 ILCS 171/4

Amends the Simplified Sales Tax and Use Tax Administration Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning multistate negotiations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Simplified Sales and Use Tax Administration
- 5 Act is amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

7 Authority to participate in negotiations. For $\underline{\text{the}}$ the purposes of reviewing or amending or 8 9 both reviewing and amending the Agreement embodying the simplification requirements as contained in Section 7 of this 10 11 Act, the State shall enter into multistate discussions. For purposes of such discussions, the State shall be represented by 12 4 delegates. One delegate shall be appointed by the President 13 14 of the Senate, one by the Minority Leader of the Senate, one by 15 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and one by the

Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
