## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 3A-15 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/3A-15) (from Ch. 122, par. 3A-15)
- 7 Sec. 3A-15. Legal representation. <u>Except as otherwise</u>
- 8 <u>provided in this Section, upon</u> <del>Upon</del> request the State's
- 9 attorney of the county where the regional superintendent's
- office is located shall act as the legal representative of the
- 11 regional superintendent of schools; however, where matters
- 12 arise which are within the exclusive jurisdiction of another
- 13 State's attorney, said State's attorney shall provide legal
- 14 representation. <u>If, in multicounty educational service</u>
- 15 regions, the county boards grant approval through an
- 16 <u>intergovernmental agreement</u>, or if, in educational service
- 17 <u>regions serving only one county, the county board grants</u>
- 18 approval, then the regional superintendent of schools is
- 19 authorized to hire private legal counsel to represent him or
- 20 her in legal matters, and each county located within the region
- 21 shall pay a per capita share of the legal fees incurred, based
- on the number of people in the county according to the most
- 23 <u>recent U.S. census.</u>
