Amends the Phenylketonuria Testing Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning rules of the Department of Public Health.

1 AN ACT concerning health.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Phenylketonuria Testing Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 240/1) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 4903)
- 7 Sec. 1. The The Illinois Department of Public Health shall promulgate and enforce rules and regulations requiring that 8 every newborn be subjected to tests for phenylketonuria, 9 hypothyroidism, galactosemia and such other metabolic diseases 10 11 as the Department may deem necessary from time to time. The Department is empowered to promulgate such additional rules and 12 regulations as are found necessary for the administration of 13 14 this Act, including mandatory reporting of the results of all 15 tests for these conditions to the Illinois Department of Public Health. 16
