1 AN ACT concerning courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Attorney Act is amended by changing Section
- 5 4 as follows:
- 6 (705 ILCS 205/4) (from Ch. 13, par. 4)
- 7 Sec. 4. Every person admitted to practice as an attorney
- 8 <u>and</u> and counsellor at law shall, before his name is entered
- 9 upon the roll to be kept as hereinafter provided, take and
- 10 subscribe an oath, substantially in the following form:
- I do solemnly swear (or affirm, as the case may be), that I
- 12 will support the constitution of the United States and the
- 13 constitution of the state of Illinois, and that I will
- 14 faithfully discharge the duties of the office of attorney and
- 15 counselor at law to the best of my ability.
