1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 690/1) (from Ch. 38, par. 81-1)
- 7 Sec. 1. Use prohibited. No person shall ingest, breathe, inhale or drink any compound, liquid, or chemical containing 8 9 toluol, hexane, trichloroethylene, acetone, toluene, ethyl acetate, methyl ethyl ketone, trichloroethane, isopropanol, 10 isobutyl ketone, methyl 11 methyl cellosolve cyclohexanone, the the alkaloids atropine, hyoscyamine, or 12 scopolamine, or any other substance for the purpose of inducing 13 14 a condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression, 15 giddiness, paralysis or irrational behavior, or in any manner changing, distorting or disturbing the auditory, visual or 16 17 mental processes. For the purposes of this Act, any such condition so induced shall be deemed to be an intoxicated 18
