Amends the Sale of Tobacco to Minors Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning penalties.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Sale of Tobacco to Minors Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 675/2) (from Ch. 23, par. 2358)
- 7 Sec. 2. Any person who violates any provision of this Act is guilty of a petty offense $\underline{\text{and}}$ and for the first offense 8 shall be fined \$200, \$400 for the second offense in a 12-month 9 period, and \$600 for the third or any subsequent offense in a 10 12-month period. One-half of each fine collected under this 11 Section shall be distributed to the unit of local government or 12 other entity that successfully prosecuted the offender and 13 one-half shall be remitted to the State to be used for 14 15 enforcing this Act.
