AN ACT concerning civil law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:


#### Abstract

Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by changing Section 7-103.117 as follows: (735 ILCS 5/7-103.117) Sec. 7-103.117. Quick-take; City of Oakbrook Terrace. Quick-take proceedings under Section $7-103$ may be used for a period of 12 months after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 94th G3rd General Assembly by the City of Oakbrook Terrace for the acquisition of property for the purpose of water main construction as follows:




LINE; THENCE NORTH 40 DEGREES 19 MINUTES 20 SECONDS EAST 46.18 FEET TO A POINT OF CURVATURE; THENCE NORTHEASTERLY ALONG THE ARC OF SAID CURVE, CONCAVE SOUTHERLY, HAVING A RADIUS OF 290.00 FEET, A CHORD BEARING OF NORTH 87 DEGREES 52 MINUTES 46 SECONDS EAST, 481.42 FEET; THENCE NORTH 45 DEGREES 26 MINUTES 11 SECONDS EAST 265.00 FEET; THENCE NORTH 87 DEGREES 36 MINUTES 32 SECONDS EAST 350.00 FEET TO SAID POINT OF BEGINNING. Beginning at a point on the east line of the southeast 1/4 of section 21-39-11, located a distance of 520 fect north of the point of intersection of the east line of the southeast $1 / 4$ of section 21 with the present northerly right of way line of Butcerficld Roadi Thence westexly along a line which forms an angle of oo degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds to the east line of the southeast $1 / 4$ of section 21 , a distance of 340 feet, to an angle point; Thence southwesterly from said angle point along a line which forms an angle of 137 degrees 49 minutes 39 seconds as measured clockise from west to south, a distance of 297 feet, to a point located 30 feet southwest and perpendicular to the south edge of the existing private road; Thence northwesterly along a curved line located 30 feet south of and parallel to the south edge of the existing private road, through an internal angle of 101 degrees 2 minutes 40 seconds, measured eounterelockwise from the northeast to the northwest, a distance of 441.7 feet, to a point located 30 feet southeast and perpendicular to the south edge of the existing private road; Thenee, northwesterly along a straight line perpendieular to the existing private road, a distanee of 30 fect to a point on the south edge of the existing private road; Thence northeasterly and southeasterly along the curved south edge of the existing private road, a distance of 461.5 feet, to a point on the south edge of the existing private road; Thence noxtheastexly along a straight line and pexpendicular to the south edge of the existing private road, a distance of 277 feet, to an angle
point (iron pipe); Thence eastexly along a straight line, from said angle point, which forms an angle of 137 degrees 49 minutes 39 seconds as measured counterclockwise from
south to east, a distance of 350 feet to a point located on the east line of the southeast 1/4 of section 21-39-11 a distance of 30 feet to the point of beginning. (Source: P.A. 93-1065, eff. 1-15-05.)
