AN ACT concerning employment.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Child Labor Law is amended by changing
Section 4 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 205/4) (from Ch. 48, par. 31.4)

Sec. 4. No minor under sixteen (16) years of age shall be employed, or permitted to work in any gainful occupations mentioned in Section 1 of this Act for more than five (5) hours continuously without an interval of at least thirty (30) minutes for meal period, <u>and and</u> no period of less than thirty (30) minutes shall be deemed to interrupt a continuous period of work.
