Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 30. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for the development of new fire districts.

Section 35. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
Storage tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
a grant to the City of Chicago for Administrative Costs
incurred as a result of the State's Underground Storage
Program.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
