1 AN ACT concerning trusts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Trusts and Trustees Act is amended by changing Section 4 and adding Section 4.26 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 4. Powers of Trustee. The trustee has the powers
- 8 specified in the Sections following this Section and preceding
- 9 Section 5 4.01 through 4.25.

- 11 (760 ILCS 5/4.26 new)
- 12 Sec. 4.26. Small trust termination. To terminate the trust
- 13 and distribute the trust estate, including principal and
- 14 <u>accrued and undistributed income</u>, if the trustee determines, in
- the trustee's sole discretion, that the market value of a trust
- is less than \$100,000 and that the costs of continuing the
- 17 <u>trust will substantially impair accomplishment of the purpose</u>
- of the trust.
- 19 Distribution shall be made to the persons then entitled to
- 20 receive or eligible to have the benefit of the income from the
- 21 trust in the proportions in which they are entitled thereto, or
- 22 <u>if their interests are indefinite</u>, to those persons per stirpes
- 23 <u>if they have a common ancestor, or if not, then in equal</u>
- 24 <u>shares. The trustee shall give notice to the persons at least</u>
- 25 30 days prior to the effective date of the termination.
- 26 <u>If a particular trustee is an income beneficiary of the</u>
- 27 <u>trust or is legally obligated to an income beneficiary, then</u>
- 28 <u>that particular trustee may not participate as a trustee in the</u>
- 29 <u>exercise of this termination power; provided, however, that if</u>
- 30 the trust has one or more co-trustees who are not so
- 31 disqualified from participating, the co-trustee or co-trustees

- 1 may exercise this power.
- 2 This Section shall not apply to the extent that it would
- 3 <u>cause a trust otherwise qualifying for a federal or State tax</u>
- 4 benefit or other benefit not to so qualify, nor shall it apply
- 5 <u>to trusts for domestic or pet animals.</u>
- 6 The provisions of this amendatory Act of the 94th General
- Assembly apply to all trusts created before, on, or after its
- 8 <u>effective date.</u>
- 9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 10 becoming law.
