AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1509 1 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1509 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The County Jail Act is amended by changing 4 5 Section 5 as follows: (730 ILCS 125/5) (from Ch. 75, par. 105) 6 7 Sec. 5. Costs of maintaining prisoners. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), all costs of 8 maintaining persons committed for violations of Illinois law, 9 shall be the responsibility of the county. Except as provided 10 in subsection (b), all costs of maintaining persons committed 11 under any ordinance or resolution of a unit of local 12 government, including medical costs, is the responsibility of 13 the unit of local government enacting the ordinance or 14 15 resolution, and arresting the person. 16 (b) If a person who has been convicted of a felony and has violated mandatory supervised release for that felony is 17 incarcerated in a county jail pending the resolution of the 18 violation of mandatory supervised release, the Illinois 19 Department of Corrections shall pay the county in which that 20 21 jail is located one-half of the cost of incarceration, as 22 calculated by the Governor's Office of Management and Budget and the county's chief financial officer, for each day that the 23

person remains in the county jail. Calculation of the per diem

- 1 cost shall be agreed upon prior to the passage of the annual
- 2 State budget.
