Makes appropriations and reappropriations to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for various purposes, including for its FY06 ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
6 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
7 General Revenue Fund to the Board of the Trustees of the
8 University of Illinois to meet ordinary and contingent
9 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006:

10	For Personal Services, including	
11	payment to the university for	
12	personal services costs incurred	
13	during the fiscal year and salaries	
14	accrued but unpaid to academic	
15	personnel for personal services	
16	rendered during the academic	
17	year 2004-2005	\$617,191,500

4 Section 10. The sum of \$1,998,500, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
6 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
7 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service
8 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the
9 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment
10 to the University for personal services and related costs
11 incurred.

12 Section 15. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
14 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
15 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
16 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
19 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
20 for the ordinary and contingent expenses for technology
21 transfer.

22 Section 25. The sum of \$10,374,575, or so much thereof as
23 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
24 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
25 made for that purpose in Article 110, Section 10 of Public
26 Act 93-842 is reappropriated from the Capital Development
27 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
28 for all costs associated with the space needs of the
29 Department of Natural Resources, Illinois Natural History
30 Survey Division and State Water Survey Division on the campus

1 of the University of Illinois in Champaign, including
2 construction, capital facilities, planning, relocation,
3 renovation and rehabilitation, mechanical systems, materials,
4 services and all other costs required to complete the work.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$3,770,922, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
7 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
8 made for that purpose in Article 110, Section 15 of Public
9 Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development
10 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
11 to plan and construct an Education and Research facility for
12 the College of Medicine in Chicago, including planning, land
13 acquisition, demolition, construction, remodeling,
14 landscaping, site improvements, equipment, extension or
15 modification of campus utility systems, relocation of
16 programs, and such expenses as may be necessary to complete
17 the facility. This appropriation is in addition to any other
18 funds appropriated for this purpose for this fiscal year.

19 Section 35. The sum of \$147,294, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
21 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
22 made for such purpose in Article 110, Section 25 of Public
23 Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development
24 Fund to the University of Illinois for digitalization
25 infrastructure for WILL-TV (Urbana-Champaign).

26 Section 40. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as
27 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
28 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
29 made for such purpose in Article 110, Section 30 of Public
30 Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development
31 Fund to the University of Illinois for digitalization

1 infrastructure for WILL-TV (Urbana-Champaign).

2 Section 45. The sum of \$94,568, or so much thereof as may
3 be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business
4 on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore made for
5 that purpose in Article 110, Section 35 of Public Act 93-842,
6 is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the
7 Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois to plan and
8 construct a Classroom and Office Building at the Springfield
9 Campus and related utility systems, including planning, land
10 acquisition, demolition, construction, remodeling,
11 landscaping, site improvements, equipment, extension or
12 modification of campus utility systems, and such expenses as
13 may be necessary to complete the facility. This appropriation
14 is in addition to any other funds appropriated for this
15 purpose for this fiscal year.

16 Section 50. The sum of \$2,757,074, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
18 business on June 30, 2005, from a reappropriation heretofore
19 made for such purpose in Article 110, Section 45 of Public
20 Act 93-842, is reappropriated from the Capital Development
21 Fund to the University of Illinois at Springfield for
22 constructing a classroom and office building, in addition to
23 funds previously appropriated.

24 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
25 2005.
