## SB1745

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-663 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for issuance of special registration plates for a retired mayor of a city or president of a village or incorporated town at an additional initial charge of $\$ 15$ and an additional renewal charge of $\$ 2$. Provides that the additional charges shall go to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 3-663 as follows:
(625 ILCS 5/3-663 new)
Sec. 3-663. Special registration plate for a retired mayor of a city or president of a village or incorporated town.
(a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special registration plates to retired mayors of cities or presidents of villages or incorporated towns, bearing appropriate wording or abbreviations indicating that the holder is a retired mayor of a city or president of a village or incorporated town. "Retired mayor of a city or president of a village or incorporated town" means any individual who has served as a mayor of a city or president of a village or incorporated town for a minimum of 6 years.

The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds.

Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
(b) The design and color of the special plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany each application. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code.
(c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a

registration fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into
the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used
by the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing
costs.

For each registration renewal period, a $\$ 2$ fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of state Special License Plate Fund.
