### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 200/10-155

Amends the Property Tax Code. Provides that land is considered used for open space purposes only if it is more than 10 acres in area and (i) conserves landscaped areas by being used as a public or private golf course, (ii) preserves historic sites, or (iii) has been certified by the Department of Natural Resources as a public benefit. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing
Section 10-155 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 200/10-155)

7 Sec. 10-155. Open space land; valuation. In all counties, in addition to valuation as otherwise permitted by law, land 8 which is used for open space purposes and has been so used for 9 the 3 years immediately preceding the year in which the 10 assessment is made, upon application under Section 10-160, 11 shall be valued on the basis of its fair cash value, estimated 12 at the price it would bring at a fair, voluntary sale for use 13 14 by the buyer for open space purposes.

15 Land is considered used for open space purposes if it is 16 more than 10 acres in area and:

(1) conserves landscaped areas by being used as a public or private golf course;
