Amends "An Act to authorize the Department of Mental Health to convey certain State-owned lands in Kane County", as amended. Provides that certain restrictions on the use of that land do not apply to a portion of that land. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. "An Act to authorize the Department of Mental 5 Health to convey certain State-owned lands in Kane County", 6 approved August 10, 1965, as amended by "An Act to amend 7 Section 3 of "An Act to authorize the Department of Mental 8 Health to convey certain State-owned lands in Kane County", 9 approved August 10, 1965", approved March 2, 1967, is amended 10 by changing Section 3 as follows:

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), the The purchaser shall agree that the land described in Section 1 13 14 shall be used for public educational and recreational purposes, 15 but may convey any part of that land to the board of a public junior college district which includes any part of Kane County 16 17 in its territory at a purchase price computed on the basis of a price per acre which does not exceed that authorized by this 18 19 Act for the conveyance to the City of Elgin. Such an agreement does not prevent the City of Elgin from selling or leasing, 20 under the conditions and in the manner provided in Division 76 21 22 of Article 11 of the Illinois Municipal Code, any part of that 23 land not so conveyed.

(b) The provisions of subsection (a) do not apply to the
