## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 210/9

from Ch. 127, par. 1709

Amends the State Fair Act. Prohibits the use of the Department of State Police for police protection at a State fairs. Requires the use of local law enforcement agencies for that purpose. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Fair Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 9 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 210/9) (from Ch. 127, par. 1709)
- 7 Sec. 9. The Department shall provide for the protection of
- 8 the State Fairgrounds, maintain and preserve order and protect
- 9 the facilities and contents from destruction by fire. The
- 10 Department is authorized to regulate vehicle traffic as well as
- 11 pedestrians within the State Fairgrounds. Persons designated
- 12 by the Department to provide protection to the State
- 13 Fairgrounds shall have full police powers.
- 14 The Department of State Police may not be used to provide
- 15 police protection at a State fair. Local law enforcement
- 16 agencies shall be used to provide police protection at a State
- 17 <u>fair.</u>

- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 20 becoming law.
