2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 2111 on page 1, by
3	replacing lines 6 through 23 with the following:
4	"(720 ILCS 5/33-3) (from Ch. 38, par. 33-3)
5	Sec. 33-3. Official Misconduct.) A public officer or
6	employee or special government agent commits misconduct when,
7	in his official capacity or capacity as a special government
8	agent, he commits any of the following acts:
9	(a) Intentionally or recklessly fails to perform any
10	mandatory duty as required by law; or
11	(b) Knowingly performs an act which he knows he is
12	forbidden by law to perform; or
13	(c) With intent to obtain a personal advantage for himself
14	or another, he performs an act in excess of his lawful
15	authority; or
16	(d) Solicits or knowingly accepts for the performance of
17	any act a fee or reward which he knows is not authorized by
18	law.
19	A public officer or employee or special government agent
20	convicted of violating any provision of this Section forfeits
21	his office or employment or position as a special government
22	<u>agent</u> . In addition, he commits a Class $2 + 3$ felony.
23	For purposes of this Section, "special government agent"
24	has the meaning ascribed to it in subsection (1) of Section

4A-101 of the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act.
