SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-664 new 625 ILCS 5/3-665 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of Iraq Campaign and Afghanistan Campaign license plates, respectively, to persons who have earned the Iraq Campaign Medal or the Afghanistan Campaign Medal from the U.S. Armed Forces. Provides that the applicant shall pay an additional fee of \$15 for original issuance of the plates, to be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Sections 3-664 and 3-665 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-664 new)

Sec. 3-664. Iraq Campaign license plates.

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 9 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 10 issue Iraq Campaign license plates to residents of Illinois who 11 have earned the Iraq Campaign Medal from the United States 12 Armed Forces. The special Iraq Campaign plates issued under 13 this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the 14 15 first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 16 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered 17 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 18 19 Code.

20 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 21 22 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be 23 issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 24 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of 25 26 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall, in his or her discretion, approve and prescribe stickers or decals as 27 28 provided under Section 3-412.

(c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original
 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This
 additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State
 Special License Plate Fund.

2	<u>Sec. 3-665. Afghanistan Campaign license plates.</u>
3	(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the
4	Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications
5	made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may
6	issue Afghanistan Campaign license plates to residents of
7	Illinois who have earned the Afghanistan Campaign Medal from
8	the United States Armed Forces. The special Afghanistan
9	Campaign plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only
10	to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and
11	motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than
12	8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire
13	according to the staggered multi-year procedure established by
14	Section 3-414.1 of this Code.
15	(b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be
16	wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The
17	Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be
18	issued as vanity plates or personalized in accordance with
19	Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to
20	designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of
21	Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall, in his or her
