Amends the Animal Control Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning impounding dogs.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning animals.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Animal Control Act is amended by changing
5 Section 9 as follows:

6 (510 ILCS 5/9) (from Ch. 8, par. 359)

7 Sec. 9. Any dog found running at large contrary to
8 provisions of this Act may be apprehended and ~~and~~ impounded.
9 For this purpose, the Administrator shall utilize any existing
10 or available animal control facility or licensed animal
11 shelter. The dog's owner shall pay a \$25 public safety fine,
12 \$20 of which shall be deposited into the Pet Population Control
13 Fund and \$5 of which shall be retained by the county or
14 municipality. A dog found running at large contrary to the
15 provisions of this Act a second or subsequent time must be
16 spayed or neutered within 30 days after being reclaimed unless
17 already spayed or neutered; failure to comply shall result in
18 impoundment.
