Amends the Animal Control Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning impounding  $\operatorname{dogs}$ .

1 AN ACT concerning animals.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Animal Control Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 9 as follows:
- 6 (510 ILCS 5/9) (from Ch. 8, par. 359)
- 7 Sec. 9. Any dog found running at large contrary to
- 8 provisions of this Act may be apprehended and and impounded.
- 9 For this purpose, the Administrator shall utilize any existing
- 10 or available animal control facility or licensed animal
- 11 shelter. The dog's owner shall pay a \$25 public safety fine,
- 12 \$20 of which shall be deposited into the Pet Population Control
- 13 Fund and \$5 of which shall be retained by the county or
- 14 municipality. A dog found running at large contrary to the
- 15 provisions of this Act a second or subsequent time must be
- spayed or neutered within 30 days after being reclaimed unless
- 17 already spayed or neutered; failure to comply shall result in
- impoundment.
