SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 120/7 new 430 ILCS 120/25 new

Amends the Illinois Manufactured Home Installers Act. Provides that a manufactured home installed on private property that is not a mobile home park must be installed so that it rests wholly on a permanent foundation. Provides that the permanent foundation must meet or exceed the requirements for a permanent foundation as defined in this amendatory Act or by federal rule. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Manufactured Home Installers Act is
amended by adding Sections 7 and 25 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 120/7 new)

7 Sec. 7. Definitions. As used in this Act:

8 "Manufactured home" is synonymous with "mobile home" and means a structure that is a factory-assembled, completely 9 integrated structure designed for permanent habitation, with a 10 permanent chassis and so constructed as to permit its 11 transport, on wheels temporarily or permanently attached to its 12 frame, from the place of its construction to the location, or 13 14 subsequent locations, at which it is placed on a support system 15 for use as a permanent habitation, and designed and situated so as to permit its occupancy as a dwelling place for one or more 16 persons. The term "manufactured home" includes manufactured 17 homes constructed after June 30, 1976 in accordance with the 18 19 federal National Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Act of 1974 and does not include an immobilized 20 mobile home as defined in Section 2.10 of the Mobile Home Park 21 22 Act.

23 <u>"Mobile home park" means a tract of land or 2 or more</u> 24 <u>contiquous tracts of land that contain sites with the necessary</u> 25 <u>utilities for 5 or more manufactured homes either free of</u> 26 <u>charge or for revenue purposes.</u>

27 <u>"Permanent foundation", for a manufactured home, means a</u> 28 <u>continuous perimeter foundation of material such as mortared</u> 29 <u>concrete block, mortared brick, or concrete that extends into</u> 30 <u>the ground below the established frost depth and to which the</u> 31 <u>home is secured with foundation bolts at least one-half inch in</u> 32 <u>diameter, spaced at intervals of no more than 6 feet and within</u> SB2359

one foot of the corners, and embedded at least 7 inches into concrete foundations or 15 inches into block foundations.

4	Sec. 25. Installation requirements. A manufactured home
5	installed on private property that is not in a mobile home park
6	on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the
7	94th General Assembly must be installed so that it rests wholly
8	on a permanent foundation. The permanent foundation must meet
9	or exceed the requirements for a permanent foundation as
10	defined in this amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly or
11	as defined by rule of the federal Department of Housing and
12	Urban Development.
