SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 780/5-3

Amends the Eliminate the Digital Divide Law. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning legislative findings.

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Eliminate the Digital Divide Law is amended by changing Section 5-3 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 780/5-3)
- 7 Sec. 5-3. Statement of legislative findings and purposes. The The General Assembly finds that the growth of high 8 technology industry, including computers, the Internet, and 9 advanced telecommunications, has created a division 10 society. Those who are able to master the tools of the new 11 12 digital technology and have access to the technology have benefited in the form of improved employment possibilities and 13 14 a higher standard of life. Those who are unfamiliar with the 15 new technologies, or do not have access to them, increasingly constrained to marginal employment and a standard 16 17 of living near the poverty level. This "digital divide" parallels existing economic, racial, and gender divisions in 18 19 society, with the more privileged members of society having 20 much greater opportunity to benefit from the new technologies than those who are less favorably situated. It is the purpose 21 22 of this Law to establish educational and economic development 23 initiatives that will bridge the digital divide, making possible a society in which all individuals can benefit from 24 25 the opportunities provided by the new technologies.
