SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/1-7-2

from Ch. 24, par. 1-7-2

Amends the Municipal Code. Provides that the Secretary of State must certify the number of inhabitants to each municipality upon the certification of any municipal census. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by changing Section 1-7-2 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/1-7-2) (from Ch. 24, par. 1-7-2)
- 7 Sec. 1-7-2. Whenever in this Code any provision thereof is based upon the number of inhabitants, the number of inhabitants 8 9 of the municipality shall be determined by reference to the 10 latest census taken by authority of the United States or this state, or of that municipality. It is the duty of the Secretary 11 of State, upon the publication of any state or United States 12 census or the certification of any municipal census referenced 13 under Section 1-7-1, to certify to each municipality the number 14 15 of inhabitants, as shown by that census. And the several courts in this state shall take judicial notice of the population of 16 17 any municipality, as the population appears from the latest 18 federal, state, or municipal census so taken.

- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
