SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 70/10 new

Amends the Statute on Statutes. Prohibits the exercise of eminent domain powers for economic development purposes. Provides that the State, units of local government, and school districts may exercise eminent domain powers only for public purposes. Preempts home rule. Effective immediately.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Statute on Statutes is amended by adding
- 5 Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 70/10 new)
- 7 Sec. 10. Property Owners' Defense Law. This Section may be cited as the Property Owners' Defense Law. Notwithstanding any 8 other statute or law to the contrary, neither the State, a unit 9 of local government, nor a school district may take or damage 10 property by the exercise of the power of eminent domain for 11 economic development purposes. The power of eminent domain 12 shall be used by the State, units of local government, or 13 school districts only for public purposes. The authorization of 14 15 the use of eminent domain proceedings to take or damage property is an exclusive power and function of the State. 16 Neither the State, a unit of local government, including a home 17 rule unit, nor a school district may exercise the power of 18 19 eminent domain otherwise than as provided in this Section. This Section is a denial and limitation of home rule powers and 20 functions under subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of 21 the Illinois Constitution. 22
- 23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 24 becoming law.
