SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 4027/25.1 new

Amends the Illinois Violence Prevention Act of 1995. Reinstates the Safe to Learn Program, a grant program operated by the Illinois Violence Prevention Authority to support and fund school-based safety and violence prevention programs that was repealed on July 1, 2005. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT relating to State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Violence Prevention Act of 1995 is amended by adding Section 25.1 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 4027/25.1 new)
- 7 Sec. 25.1. Safe to Learn Program.
- 8 (a) The Authority shall establish and administer a grant
 9 program to be known as the Safe to Learn Program. Funds
 10 appropriated to the Authority for this program shall be used to
 11 support and fund school-based safety and violence prevention
 12 programs that address any or all of the following components:
- 13 (1) Building security, including but not limited to
 14 portable metal detectors.
- 15 (2) Violence prevention and intervention.
- (3) Crisis management.
- 17 <u>(4) Training of teachers and other school personnel.</u>
- (b) Ten percent of any funds appropriated for this program 18 19 may be used by the Authority to provide technical assistance and program support. Five percent of any funds appropriated for 20 21 this program may be used by the Authority for administration of this program. Up to \$500,000 of any funds appropriated for this 22 program may be used by the Authority for each of 3 years to 23 conduct a demonstration and evaluation of a comprehensive 24 prekindergarten through 12th grade school-based violence 25 26 prevention program in 3 pilot sites in this State. The Authority shall distribute any remaining funds appropriated 27 for this program to school districts in the form of grants, 28
- 30 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 31 becoming law.
